

POST-SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS (PSEO) NON-RESIDENTIAL OPTION

The educational system of the state of Ohio allows talented high school students an opportunity to earn college credit prior to completion of their high school programs through Post-Secondary Enrollment Options. Post-Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) are designed to complement and supplement a high school's college preparatory curriculum.

PSEO options: (PSEO can only be started in the fall semester)

- Option A:** College credit is awarded for courses successfully completed at MVNU. The student pays tuition, fees, textbooks and materials. Credit earned does not affect the student's high school record, and does not count toward units for graduation.
- Option B:** High school and college credit are awarded for courses successfully completed at MVNU. Fees for tuition and materials are partially reimbursed by the state of Ohio (books must be returned at the end of the semester). Credit earned becomes part of the student's high school record and necessary to meet graduation requirements.

Admission

*The following requirements must be met to be considered for PSEO at
Mount Vernon Nazarene University:*

- * Must be a high school Junior or Senior.
- * Must have achieved a 3.00 grade point average in all high schoolwork attempted through the end of the academic year prior to enrollment.
- * Must have achieved an ACT composite score of at least 23 with subscores 19 or above, or SAT combined score of at least 1050.
- * Must be participating in a college preparatory curriculum and have completed the following:
 - The units of English required for grade level (three years for seniors, two for juniors)
 - Two of the following: Algebra I, Algebra II and Geometry
 - Two units of science (one must be a lab science)
 - Two units of social Studies
 - Foreign language for grade level (two years of the same language for seniors, one for juniors)
- * Must complete the PSEO application with \$25 application fee (nonrefundable).
- * Must include a letter of recommendation from the high school guidance counselor.
- * Must include an official high school transcript.
- * Must send an official copy of the ACT or SAT to MVNU (a high school copy is not sufficient).
- * Must contact the high school about their intent to participate in PSEO.
- * Must apply before May 1 since space is limited (*a partial transcript of high school work may be submitted with the application with a final transcript sent to complete the file prior to registration*)

Registration

- * Students accepted into the non-residential PSEO program register for classes at the PSEO Orientation held in mid-August (attendance is required).
 - * The Assistant University Registrar at MVNU advises PSEO students related to course registration. Student's schedules must be reviewed by the Assistant Registrar in all subsequent semesters for continuance in the program.
 - * Degree-seeking students at MVNU have course selection priority. PSEO students will be registered on a space-available basis. High school seniors are given priority over juniors. MVNU reserves the right to cancel classes, to change instructors, or to limit registration in courses.
 - * The process of being confirmed for enrollment purposes will be reviewed at PSEO Orientation.
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Additional Information

- * PSEO students are subjected to the same standards of academic and social conduct, disciplinary policies and procedures and grading system as other MVNU students (including that if a student is to miss a class for any reason, he/she is to directly contact professors for missed assignments and/or information). See pages 27-28 of the 2010-11 MVNU *University Catalog* for details.
 - * No additional financial aid is available to PSEO residential students beyond the state subsidy for tuition and books. Students must make arrangements with Student Accounts during New Student Orientation for payment of tuition and fees under Option A or payment for fees under Option B.
 - * Non-residential (commuting) students may only register *for the following each semester*.**
- ** Juniors may register for up to 7 credit hours per semester (or no more than two courses).**
- **Seniors may register for up to 9 credit hours per semester (or no more than three courses).**
